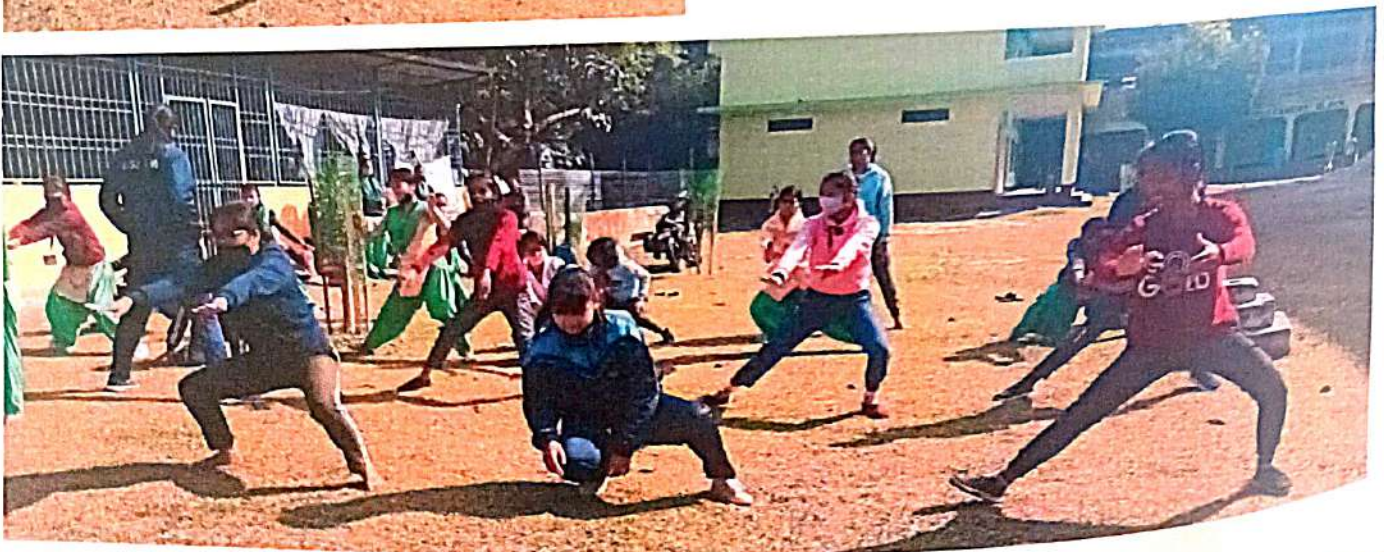
Saraswati Puja Celebration

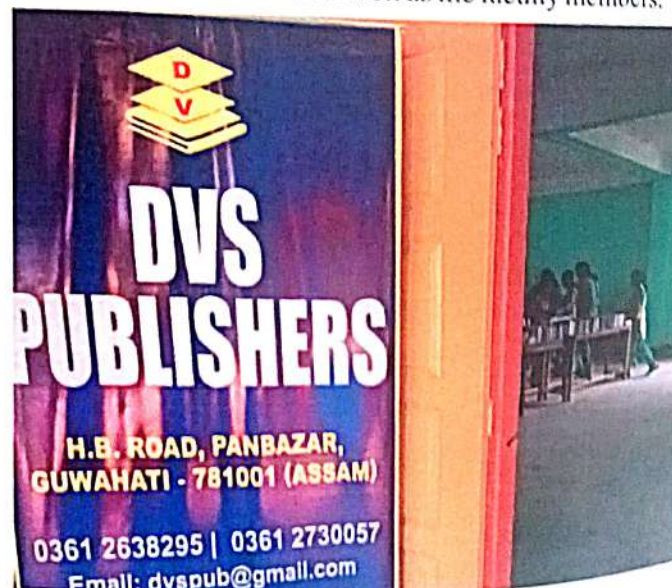
International Women's Day

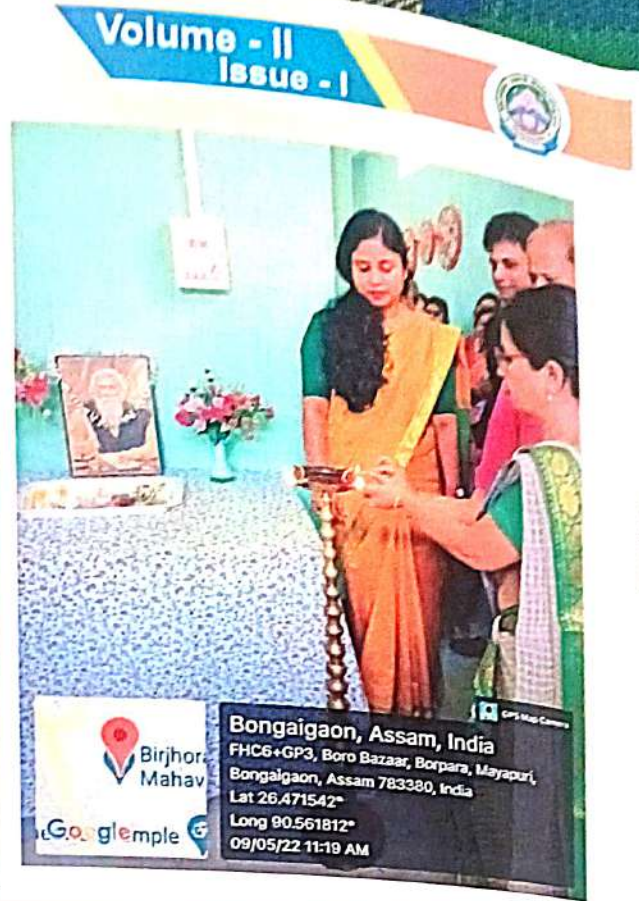
Student Orientation Programme on Awareness and Usage of Swayam Courses
